

Spending time on manual tasks contributes to clinician burnout and reduces time spent with patients


Only **24%** report their organizations are effective at using technology to reduce the time and cost of processing clinical documentation

HEALTHCARE LEADERS SEE MODERN CONNECTED CARE PLATFORMS AS A SOLUTION


64% of health systems are looking to add a connected care platform to deliver unstructured enterprise content, images and video for access within their EHR workflow



49% anticipate purchasing one within the next 12 to 24 months

As part of these plans,

61% are developing or have identified the need for an enterprise imaging strategy but haven't fully deployed it yet



47% of health systems are planning to establish a vendor neutral archive as part of this strategy



55% are planning or investigating automated classification of unstructured data to speed its use in core systems



51% of health systems are looking to acquire a solution to build new applications to support connecting content, process workflows and case management for their healthcare ecosystem



45% of health systems are looking to deploy a content services solution in the cloud
